# WA STATE GRANGE PHOTOGRAPHY CONTEST

- 1. This contest is open to both Grange members and non-members. Non-members must be sponsored by a subordinate Grange. Receiving compensation of any kind does not prohibit a member from taking part in the contest.
- 2. If the National Grange holds a national photo contest, one entry will be selected at the state level judging to represent WA state. Restrictive criteria, such as Grange membership and/or professional status, will be included in the selection process.
- 3. The photographer must select the class for his/her entry.
- 4. A print may be entered in only one class.
- 5. Participants may enter all classes using separate prints.
- 6. Participants may have more than one entry per class. This will allow for a bigger and better photography contest at the Pomona level.
- 7. Entries must have been completed after May 15 (or the Pomona judging date) of the previous year.
- 8. Prints may be made by a commercial processor, but must have been taken by the entrant.
- 9. Only minor manipulations, such as color corrections, elimination of red eye, or cropping are allowed. Other manipulations are not allowed on any entry.
- 10. At the state level, matting and backing with matte board is required for all photos. There must be a minimum 1" mat margin on all sides and a maximum mat margin of 2 ½" on all sides. Please be sure the photo is securely attached. **NO FRAMES OR COVERINGS OF ANY TYPE.**
- 11. The Pomona Lecturer has the authority to adjust the rules as necessary for the Pomona contest, including whether matting is required at the Pomona level.
- 12. Photos must a minimum size of 5"x7" and a maximum size of 11"x14". This does not include the matt.
- 13. Title is optional.
- 14. Age of contestants in the youth and junior groups will be as of January 1 of the current year.
- 15. All entries will be judged at the Pomona level. The highest scoring entry in each class should receive a purple ribbon and be forwarded to the state contest, held during the State Grange Convention in June.
- 16. Judging in the photography contest will be based on: composition and arrangement, interest, presentation (including matting), technique, and appropriateness for category entered.
- 17. All entries will be awarded ribbons. Rosettes will be awarded at the state level to the highest placing entry in each class.
