The scholarships must be used at an institution offering courses leading to a certificate or degree in the chosen field of profession or vocation. This includes community colleges as well as institutions offering academic degree programs.

Payments will be made <u>directly</u> to the college or university of the recipient's choice.

PLEASE READ INSTRUCTIONS <u>CAREFULLY</u>.

The Scholarship Committee will base its awards on the following:

- 1. Scholastic ability.
- 2. Participation in Grange activities.
- 3. Participation in extracurricular activities including work history, 4-H, FFA, church, Scouts, school clubs, sports, music, etc.
- 4. Character references.
- 5. Completeness in filling out application forms.

<u>All</u> pages of the application must be returned <u>before the deadline</u> to be eligible. *Incomplete applications will not be considered.*
